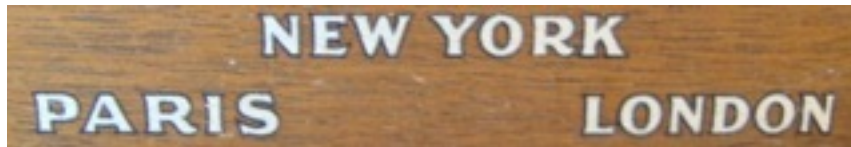


It's not like my mother is a maniac or a raving thing. She just goes a little mad sometimes. We all go a little mad sometimes. Haven't you?

From the Hiking Club:

We're back with a regular schedule. Below is the schedule for the next 2 weeks. I'm still tinkering with the schedule thru Aug.

Sun May 8; 9:00 a.m.: Escalante Canyon Forks Trail (**Palmer Gulch**); **4-5 miles RT; Easy-Moderate.** This steadily uphill walk on a side road passes thru wonderful rock formations including cap rocks that look like a hwy from across the canyon. Off to the right is an overlook of an old homestead. Directions: Take Escalante Canyon turnoff (L off Hwy 50 north of Delta) and travel 25 miles to “The Forks” where the road splits. Opt to park here or turn R & travel 1+ miles. Pull off road. Note: Toilet on L just past Capt. Smith’s cabin. *Pringles & Millers, Coordinators*

Wed May 11; 9:00 a.m.; San Miguel River/Keystone Gorge Trail (**Telluride**) **5 mile loop; 300 ft; Moderate.** We’ll combine this section of trail, which follows along the scenic San Miguel River, with the Galloping Goose Trail which it loops into. The river trail is narrow in places, with 2 bridge crossings. Directions: Take Hwy 62 to Hwy 145, turn L and travel to junction. Turn R with hwy, passing service station. Take next R for short distance to parking area at bus stop. Note: There is a bakery/coffee shop near TH. *Rich & Vera, Coordinators*

Sun May 15; 9:00 a.m.: “**Ladies’ Choice**” Hike. *Pam Miller, Coordinator*

All hikers meet at Ted’s parking lot a few minutes before scheduled time to set up car pools. Bring boots, water, windbreaker, sun protection. Gloves, warm layer, and raingear advisable for mountain hikes (early mornings can be chilly & clouds roll in about noon). Don't forget a nutritious snack & lunch (energy can drop rapidly on mtn trails).

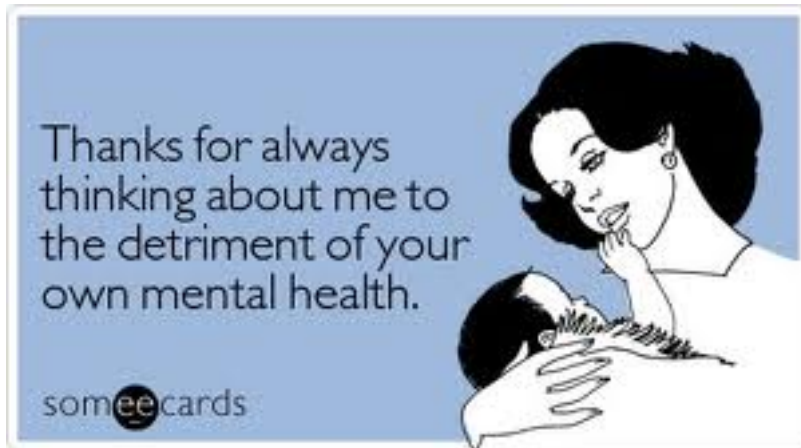
