Spa Day is coming up on the 17th. Please sign up at the reception desk.

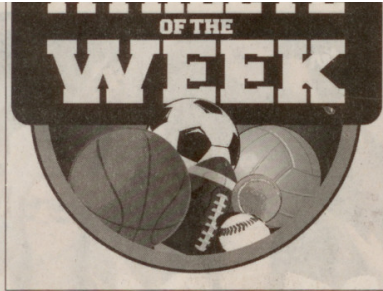
Bocce is now going to be played on Tuesday's at 6:00.
