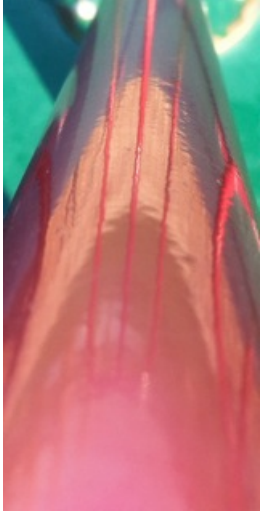
It's Halloween season again, Let's follow the great pumpkin through another lovely update -

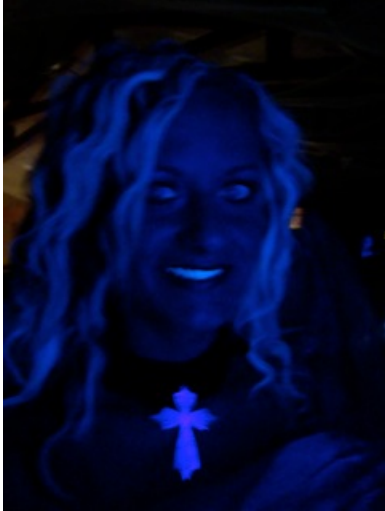
