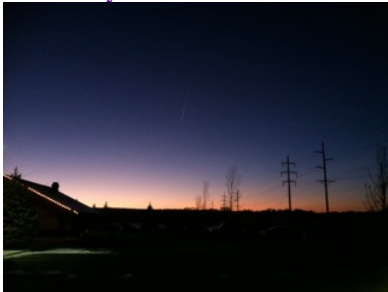

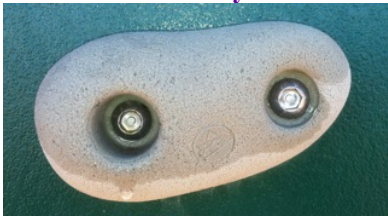

The Christmas Caroling was fun...cold, but fun! Nice look Nanuk!!

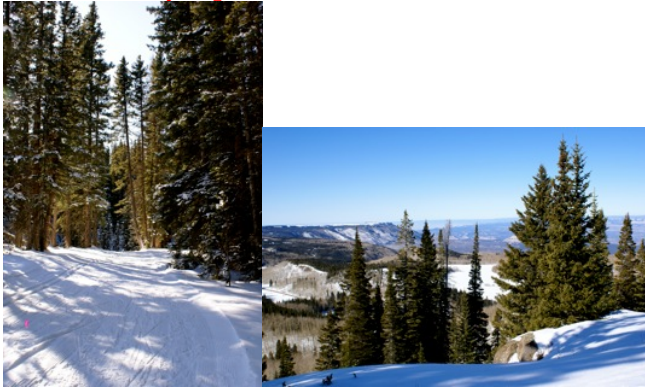


From The Cobble Creek Laboratory:
