He was on the 1996 Race Across America team that set a 50+ record of 5 days, 11 hours. He has worked with hundreds of riders at PAC Tour Training Camps, Carpenter/Phinney Bike Camps, and Dirt Camp and has coached at every Desert Camp since its inception in 1996. He is also a speaker who has given presentations at cycling events around the U.S. including El Tour de Tucson, the Hotter'n Hell Hundred and to business and professional groups.
