

**Standing Rules 2017**  
**Cobble Creek Women's Golf Association**

The CCWGA 2017 play day season begins March 28 and continues weekly through October 3. Weekly play is on Tuesday mornings for both 9 and 18 hole players.

Signup sheets for Tuesday play will be on the bulletin board. Sign up by Sunday at noon. If you need to cancel, you must call the play day chair. Pairings, with the exception of the two "pick your own 4-some", will be made by the play day chair and will be emailed to you. All players should report to the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their tee times.

Events will be played according to USGA Rules and Regulations. If you can't resolve a rules question within your foursome, circle the hole, play two balls and consult the Pro Shop **before** signing and submitting your scorecard. Report your results by turning in a signed and attested scorecard to the Pro Shop. **Adjust your score before posting.**

Special events are scheduled throughout the season. Events already scheduled are listed at [cobblecreek.com/ccwga](http://cobblecreek.com/ccwga) and will be emailed to all members. Copies are also available on the bulletin board. Special criteria for each event will be emailed and posted.

To play in the 9 or 18 hole Club Championship a player must compete with the group in which they played the majority of their play day rounds with a minimum of five rounds. The special events will count toward the five rounds needed to play the Championship. A member whose participation was limited due to illness or injury may request a waiver to compete from the Board.

To qualify for "Most Improved" at the end of the season, the player must compete regularly during the season with the CCWGA.

**CCWGA qualifications for a hole-in-one award:** any paid up member who achieves a hole-in-one on any Tuesday play day, all CCWGA and CCMGA special events.

Travel Team members shall be credited for birdies made during travel team play at Cobble Creek.

**All balls must be holed out at CCWGA events unless a player chooses to disqualify herself from that day's competition.** That player's score must still be posted. In a team competition she is not disqualified if she picks up if she is out of contention on that hole.
