#### **Treasurer's Report**

- 1. Cash position remains strong as we begin the new year but there are significant capital expenditures that will erode this cash in 2025.
- 2. Issues related to the use of ACH have been resolved and the BOD is signing up to use ACH to pay Clubhouse and Golf dues as a test before making available to all members. Dues can still be paid by check and credit cards can be used but with a 2% service charge. Credit card use costs the Club 3% and the use of ACH costs the Club 1%.
- 3. Problems with ForeUp regarding punch cards, inventory and membership dues have held up the preparation of 2024 year end financials. These financials will be delayed until mid-March.

### **Golf Operations Report**

- 1. Work on the gabion wall at the 16<sup>th</sup> green continues with the cages for the wall being delivered this week. The cages will then be filled with rock and the wall backfilled and compacted.
- 2. The front nine will be open on February 26<sup>th</sup>. The back nine will be available for play the week of March 7<sup>th</sup> but holes 15 and 16 may still be unplayable due to work on the gabion wall.
- 3. The two greens mowers will be delivered mid-March
- **4.** The new rental golf carts will be delivered in April.

#### **Food and Beverage Report**

- 1. The Club Manager has hired an assistant who will focus on events and tavern management.
- 2. Arturo our cook is back from is time out of the Country. We may be re-working the menu to incorporate new items and suspend items that are of less interest.
- 3. As the Pro Shop returns to regular hours next week, so with the Tavern.
